

Check List For Boarding or Daycare

WHAT TO BRING:

- **FORMS - New Clients** - Please print and fill out the forms on our website prior to bringing your dog for their assessment.
 - **Registration & Agreement Packet** - Includes Client, Pet, Medical Information, Agreement & Veterinary Release Form
 - A copy of your Dogs Vaccination Record
- **FORMS - Returning Clients** - If you have any changes to the information we have on file, please print the appropriate form from our website and bring it with you.
 - **Client Information** - Includes changes to your emergency contacts
 - **Pet Information**
 - **Medical & Emergency Information** - Includes Vaccinations
 - **Veterinary Release Form**
- **Food & Treats** - Bring 1-2 extra portions just in case you're delayed getting home.
- **Medication** - Make sure it is clearly labeled with your pet's name, the correct dosage & frequency.
 - *Don't forget the "Pill Pockets," oral dispensers or needles.*
- **Bed, Mat or Blanket** - It gives your pooch comfort when there's something familiar from home.
- **Sturdy Collar or Harness & Leash:**
 - All dogs must arrive and leave on leash and under the control of the owner.
 - ID Tags with current contact information is required
- **Written Instructions** -
 - Feeding schedule, amount per meal, is it mixed with something else?, etc...
 - Medication schedule, frequency and dosage
- **Flea & Tick Preventative** - Must be current with preventative.
- **Please remember that if there is not enough food or supplies to last the duration of your dogs visit, we will purchase additional food. We cannot guarantee the same brand or type. Payment for replacement food and other supplies is due at pick up.**

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- **Dishes, Toys or Crates**
- **Although I make every attempt to prevent dogs from destroying another dogs belongings, I cannot guarantee it will never happen. Do not bring anything of value and keep in mind that any supplies brought may not be returned in the same condition.**
